We received information from Mrs Bill Kandle 2439 W 5TH, Irving, Texas. 62-3-8965 that her brother, Buell Woolley Frasier W-M-19 phone address, took Lee Oswald to work on the meaning of the murder & that she saw Oswald put a long package in the back seat of his brother's 1954 Black Chev 4 dr 1963 Tex Lic # VK 3926 (See her affidavit). She said her brother wasn't home but visiting ^{with} their father. We Williams at Parkland Hospital, we checked with Parkland Hospital but they didn't have a Dan Williams there. We finally located Dan Williams at the Irving Professional Center, Room #30 Det. Rose contacted Det. John A. McCabe of the Irving P.D. & asked him to check them for Frasier. Det. McCabe called us back stating he had the boy at the Irving P.D. We went there immediately and got Frasier & accompanied by McCabe went to the Irving Professional Center and searched Frasier ~~in~~ 1954 Black Chev Tex Lic VK 3926. We found nothing of importance. We then went to 2439 W 5th with Frasier she showed us where he kept his 303 Cal rifle & binoculars (see property room invoice). Frasier's sister, Mrs Kandle came to the location & we brought Frasier & Mrs Kandle to the homicide office.
