The slub and button were turned over to Coat Boughty of I D Bureau. At 3:30 pm Cast Fritz of the Homocide Bureau advised officers to take the 38 3 & Y snubnose (Ser / 510210) that was used in the shooting and 3 live 38 shell and also turned these over to Capt Doughty. The personal affects of fficer Tippit was also turned over to Capt. Doughty & of the I 3 Bureau.
