While waiting for Justice of the Peace Johnson, Dets Turner and Moore, the landlady,
MrsRoberts, and a Mrs Johnson saw Lee Oswald's picutare on telivision and identified him
as the O.H. Lee whendrakes as the same person. When the search warrent arrived they searched
Oswald's room and found an empty pistol holster, mans and numerous Communist books, pamplets
and handbills for the "Fair Play for Cuba. Also an undisarable discharge from the Marine
Corps. All these articles were Brought to the minutal H&R bureau. When Dect Senkel
returned to the H&R office Capt Fritz had him take an affadavit from Mrs Oswald with an
interpretary interpreter, Mr U.A. Brourantus and Mrs Ruth Paine translating the affadavit.
Det Adamcik who understands some Russian also sat in on the taking of the affadavit.
