Subject; Information regarding the murder of Lee Oswald.

Sir; At approximately 14:15 pm I was instructed by Lt. Swain to proceed to the Jail office area and stand by that location. On arrival I found the walkway in front of the jail office erowddd with cameramen and reporters. I was standing in front of one of the jail office windows when Officers brought Oswald from the jail elevator across the jail office and out the side door entering into the basement at that point I momentairly lost sight of them. I heard a shot and immediatly pulled my revolver and forced myself through the Newsmen into the drive outside the jail office where I observed Officers lifting Oswald and carrying him back into the jail Office and other Officers struggling with another white male. I immediately secured the ramp to main street along with Lt. Swain and two other Officers. I helped keep this area secure from anyone coming or leaving untill after the ambulance came and picked up Oswald. At that time I was ordered by Captain Jones to go with a group of detectives under the supervision of Lt. Mc Kinney to Parkland Hospital. I stayed at Parkland Hospital untill I was ordered back to the City Hall.
