Subject: Information regarding the murder of Lee Oswald

Sire

On Movember 24, 1963 at about 12:15 EM, I was told by Lt. Swain to report to the Lobby of the basement of the City hall, and station myself somewhere in the basement lobby and stand by, as Oswald was being transferred to the County Jail. I went immediately to the Lobby and stationed myself infront of the first window of the jail office. At that time the lobby was crowded with Camera men and reporters. I saw Oswald as he was escerted from the elevator by several Officers across the jail Office to the ramp door at which point I lost sight of him. Moments later I heard a shot and locked out in the ramp and saw several Officers struggling with a white male. I Immediately ram out into the ramp and observed several officers carrying semeone back into the jail Office. I was told at that time by Capt. Jones to guard the door to the jail Office. I remained at the door untill later I was teld by Capt. Jones to go with Lt. Mc.Kinney to parkland. I was stationed at the door of the Intensive eare ward by Lt. Mc Kinney, and remained at that location untill teld to return to the city hall.
