affidavit from Paine. A ride was then secured for him so he could return home. I ended my tour of duty at 10:00 pm.Sunday, November 24, I was at home watching TV when the news of Oswald's being shot came on. I reported to the office as soon as I could get there, arriving approximately 1:30 pm.

Shortly thereafter, Tet. G. P. Bose and myself went to Judge Joe Brown, Jr.'s house and obtained a search warrant for Jack Fubre's apartment at 223 S. Ewing, Ant. 207. We then went to this anartment and searched it. Shortly after we arrived there Judge Brown, Jr. joined us and was present while search was completed. Te took from this spartment some money (see property room invoice) and some telephone numbers. We then returned to the office, and I ended my tour of duty at approximately midnight.
