Capt. Prits directed me to return to the basement and have the Supervisor
Officer to obtain the names of overyone in the basement. I went to Capt. C. E.
Talbert and gave him Capt. Frits's message. I then moved Capt. Frits's car
out of the driveway where the ambulance could get to the jail office. When
the ambulance came, I rode in the ambulance with Oswald to Farkland Hospital.
I stayed at Parkland Hospital until Oswald was pronounced dead. Det. C. W.
Frown and I went with Oswald's body to the morgue where we waited until Dr.
Earl Bose made his preliminary pictures of the body prior to the autopsy.
I turned over Oswald's clothing to Dr. Earl Bose, and returned to the Romicide
Office in the City Pall approximately 5:30 PM. I stayed in the Fomicide
Office with Mr. Stewart and went through the property of Oswald. I made
coules of letters and identification from Oswald's property for Mr. Stewart.
I also made copies of all the affidavite that had been taken by the Homicids
Office and Sheriff's Office for Mr. Sorrells of the Secret Service.
