REPORT ON OFFTGER'S DUFIES IN REGARDS TO THE PRESIDWNT 'S MURDER

Friday, November 22, 1963 at 19:25 pm Marvin Johnson 879 and myself, while working as partners, went into the Dales Cafe, located at 3007 Lemon Avenue, to eat lunch. Johnson and I sat dowa at the table and looked at the manu. I told Johnson to order for me that I was going to call the office and tell them that we would be out at this location. I called the office and talked to It, Wells, I told It. Wells that we woulc be out to eat, and the Lieutenant infocmed me that the President had been shot and to return to the office imasiately, I hung up the phone, told Johnson that the Prestident had been shot, ari we were to return to the office immadiately. We got into our car and returned to the city hell and our office.

Upon our retwre to the office Lt. Wells told us to report to F1m and Houston. We pot into our car and drove to Flm and Houston and arrived there approximately 19:50 mm. Detective Johnson and wyself entered the building, Teras Book Depository, and went directly to the 6th floor where we contacted Captain Fritz. Captain Frite put Johnson protecting part of the scene on the 6th floor and myself protecting the part of the scene where the window was that the shooting took place. I remained at this location in the Texas Book Depository on the 6th floor whtil Det, Studehaker of the crime lab search section had dusted the windows and surrounding boxes for prints. I found a long brown paper sack looking item that looked homemade. It was bencath and to the left of the windon where the shooting took place. I believed this to be the container that the rifle Oswald used was in. Det. Studebaker dusted this item and initialed it. Det. Johnson and ryself initialed it also. Det. Johnson had a Dr. Pepper bottie thet was in the area of the scene that he was protecting. Det. Stridebaker dusted this item for prints.
