There was a City of Dellas map found, a leather holster, an address book with the name of Lee Harvey Oswald in it, numerous letters with his name on them, clothes, shoes, shaving kit, a paper back book entitled, "A Study of the U. S. S. H. and Communism", a pair of binochlars, several pamphlets, and handbills for the "Fair Play for Suba", Undesirable Discharge from Harine Sorps for Lee Hervey Oswald. This property was all taken to Room 317, City Hall.

I was in the process of looking through this property in Room 317, Gity Hall at about 7:00 PM, Nowesbar 22, 1963, when I was advised by Capt. J. W. Fritz to talk to Mrs. Marine Gewald, wife of Loe Harvey Cowald. I talked to her in the presence of Mrs. Ruth Paine in Room 316, Gity Hall. With Mrs. Paine as interpreter, I took an affidavit from Marine Gewald. Miss Mary Fatten was the Motary and was present when a Mr. J. A. Brourantus and Frs. Ruth Paine translated the affidavit. Bet. J. P. Adamoik was also present. These persons, with the exception of Mary Ratten, were also present when the rifle found at the scene of the shooting was shown to Mrs. Marine Oswald. See her affidavit for her comments on the rifle.

On November 23, 1963 I talked to Mr. Joe Molina. See statement for information on him. Be could not shed any lip't on Gauald's activity as he was not in close om tact with Gewald during the day of Movember 22, 1963.

November 23, 1963 at 2:15 PM I was on stage in show up room when show up was held with #1 John Thurman Horn, #2 David Knapp, #3 Lee Harvey Oswald, #1 Daniel Lujan. I could not see into Assembly Room to see who was viewing the show up. I did recognize Det. J. R. Leavelle's voice, did not see him.
