November 21, 1963 I came on duty at 12:00 Noon. I was returning from church mervices when I heard on a news broadcast that Lee Harvey Ouweld had been shot. This was at 11:30 AM. I took my family home and reported for duty at 12:00 Noon. I was present when Jack Ruby was taken to Capt. Frits's office at about 1:00 PM. I talked to Lts. Swain and Swart and listed property that they had taken from Jack Ruby's car. I went with Det. Turner and Lt. Swain and placed this property in Police Property Poem. William F. Alexander of the Dellas District Attorney's office was also with us at the 1026 North Pockley address at time search warrant was executed.
