The man then stated that if the President came he might not get out of Dallas alive or a lot of people might not want to see him get out alive. I would not swear as to which statement he made. I saw the picture of the man arrested by the Police in the paper and I believe that the man that was in the cafe is the same man. However, I am not positive. I could not swear to it.
