MICROSCOPIC:

Aprica: There is disruption with fresh hemorrhage. No inflammation or organization,

Meart: There are hemorrhages in the epicardial fat, mild interstitial edema and focal fragmentation of the muscle fibers.

Lung: Areas of atolectasis and focal alveolar homorrhagic extravasations.

Mere Diagnotion with fresh homorphages, otherwise non-contributory.

Bowel: There are disruptions of the stomach with hemorrhages adjacent. The remainder of the bowel sections are non-contributory.

Spleen: There is disruption along one margin, otherwise non-contributory.

Thyroid: Non-contributory.

Pancreas: Hon-contributory.

Gallbladder: Hon-contributory.

Prostate: Mon-contributory.

Lyaph Nodes: Non-contributory.

Adrenals: There is extensive fresh hemorrhage adjacent, otherwise non-contributory.

Skin: Section through the entrance wound shows disruption with fresh hemorrhages. There is no organization or inflammation. Some amorphous debris and fibers in the depths of the wound.

Eddrey: Sections show disruption of the right kidney with hemorrhages which are marked in the pelvic fat and perirenal tissue.

Central Mervous System: Multiple sections are examined and they are non-contributory.
