## HICROSCOPIC

Aorta: There is disruption with fresh hemorrhage. Wo inflammation or organization.

Heart: There are homorrhages in the epicardial fat, mild interstitial edema and focal fragmentation of the muscle fibers.

Imm: Areas of stelectasis and focal elveolar homorrhagic extravasations.

Idver: Disruption with fresh hesorrhages, otherwise non-contributory.

Bowel: There are disruptions of the stomach with hemorrhages adjacent. The remainder of the bowel sections are non-contributory.

Spleen: There is disruption along one margin, otherwise non-contributory.

Thyroid: Non-contributory.

Panoreas: Non-contributory.

Gallbladder: Non-contributory.

Prostate: Non-contributory.

Lymph Nodes: Non-contributory.

Adrenals: There is extensive fresh hemorrhage adjacent, otherwise non-contributory.

- Sidn: Section through the entrance wound shows disruption with fresh hemorrhages. There is no organization or inflamation. Some emorphous debris and fibers in the depths of the wound.
- Kidney: Sections show disruption of the right kidney with hemorrhages which are marked in the pelvic fat and perirenal tissue.

Centrel Nervous System; Multiple sections are examined and they are non-contributory
