is the best of all the circumstantial evidence that the police had the "right man".

But it remained for the US Supreme Court, in 1954, to completely abolish the Constitution, according to its lights.

Throwing out a big smoke screen by saying, in an official "judicial" decree, that states' rights (guaranteed by Amendment 10) were no longer in effect, in the segregation matter, it then began to make a series of "decisions" breaking down our defenses against the encroachment of Communism

in Washington and the 50 states.
In the next several years 16 subversive "decisions" (not all of them unanimous as the first one was) came from the Supreme Court hopper. All of them were aimed against state, city and US law enforcing agencies in keeping down the growing subversion.

In March 1962 Senator Eastland (Miss) gave to the Senate the voting records of nine members of the Supreme Court on these pro-Communist "decisions".

This record showed that five of the nine "high court" members had voted consistently against America and in favor of the Russian program for a Communist takeover.

Mr. Kennedy himself was guilty of Constitution violations when he sent 15,000 Federal troops into Mississippi to enforce an illegal and lawless decision of the "high" court.


