

After two months I resigned from this organization because its policies were not in keeping with my convictions. This organization was composed primarily of Jewish women who were promoting aid for Israel.

Q. Mrs. Grant, were you ever a member of the communist party?

A. No sir.

Q. Have you ever been a member of the Democratic or Republican Party?

A. In 1947 or 1948 a friend of mine, Mrs. Evelyn Roberts, solicited my membership in a Democratic party organization. I joined with a small cash donation.

Q. Is your brother's name Jack Ruby?

A. Yes.

Q. To the best of your knowledge, has your brother Jack ever been a member of any organization?

A. Yes, I recall that my brother Jack was in the Scraphandlers Union in Chicago, Illinois, and one of his associates in this union was a Mr. Leon Cook, now deceased.

Q. Mrs. Grant, was your brother a member of any other organization to the best of your knowledge or belief?

A. It is also possible that my brother belongs to AGMA, an entertainers' union, and possibly a musicians' union, but I do not know about this.

Q. Mrs. Grant, do you have reason to believe that your brother Jack is a Communist?

A. No.

Q. Has your brother Jack ever expressed sentiments for any Communist organization or country?

A. No.

Q. Has your brother Jack ever expressed hatred or animosity towards any organization or country?

A. I do not ever recall discussing this with my brother Jack.
