HARRISON SR. who lives at 1718 NORTH TRAVIS RTRATT, LIBERTY, TEXAS, Telephone number FR-6-3543 Area Code 713 that could possibly show a connection between JACK RUBY and LES HARVET GSV (LD. The following is a result of this investigation.

MR HAR IS S stated that he had received information that a guard named CASINESS (fau) of the Texas Frison System had a negro inmate under his supervision that knew JACE RUBY, and that Ruby had contacted this negro about moving Oswald from Callas to California, prior to the assessination of President Rennedy.

7E.A.TH C. CASINESS, a guard at the synne Farm of the ISC, was contacted about the above mentioned negro. Cabiness stated that he knew nothing about this negro. Cabiness stated that what he had said was mis-construed and that the man we (the undersigned officers) wanted to talk to was BeeBY CONTROL IMPNOR when is an impact at the Synne Farm.

Simons stated that he had known Muby for a number of years and that he always thought that Buby was a communist. Simons also stated that the negro in question was Makifilm? HATTON, c-m, TDCy 169432. Matten told dimons that he had worked for Jack Ruby at the Vegas Club defore he went to the pemientiary. Simons stated that Fatton and mothing of suby asking him to move devald to California.
