SUBJECT was interviewed by the undersigned efficers with the following results.

SUBJECT stated that on Friday Movember 22, 1963, at approximately 2:15 A. H. a white male, five feet seven inches tall, 140 lbs. with dark hair, entered the LUCAS H & B GAFE, located at 3520 OAKLANN, where SUBJECT is a weitress. SUBJECT stated that this man was positively LES MARVT OSWALD. SUBJECT said this man stated that he was weiting for JACK RUBY. SUBJECT stated that JACK RUBY entered the CAFE a short time later but did not sit in the booth with this man. The man believed to be GSWALD went ever and sat with JACK RUBY. SUBJECT stated that RUBY and the man believed to be OSWALD left at approximately 2:45 A. H. At this point in the interview the SUBJECT stated that she could not be mure that this man was OSWALD but if he had a small deep scar on his left check, it was him.

SUBJECT stated that a few days efter the assessmation she reseived an anonymous telephone call telling her to get out of town or she would die.

Before the interview ended the SUBJNCT stated that she could not be positive but she thought the man with RUBY was OSWALD.
