Q 13 A And he called me that night. 14 What was that conversation? Q 15 A He told me that night he was going to the syna-16 gogue and that his place was going to be closed -- his 17 business. That was the last time. 18 Q The last time you talked to him? 19 A Yes. 20 Q You haven't talked to him since he was jailed? 21 A No. 22 Q From the time you met him up until -- for some 23 years you have gone with him socially?
