At approximately 11:00 AM I was assigned to the sall just outside of the jail office. Our instructions were to keep the passage-way clear when we observed Oswald being brought out.

The News people were all asked to stay out in the drive and to keep the passage-way clear. They were also asked not to ank Oswald any questions. As Oswald was being brought out.

As Oswald was brought out, the passa, e-way was starting to fill up, I stepped a little behind and to Oswalds right to try and prevent unyone setting to him from this side.

I heard a shot and then turned to see seve al detectives take subject into custody. As he was restrained I observed, what appeared to be a 38 caliber shub nose revolver being taken from his right hand.
