Sir:

Pursuant to instructions of Captain W. P. Gannaway, the following information is submitted.

WILSON TURLINGTON, w-m, of 1113 Sycamore Street, Wambahechie, Texas is a close friend and associate of Subject. Turlington owns and operates Turlington's Grocery, 1113 Sycamore, Wambahechie.

Turlington was an employee of Subject at the Silver Spur Club, 1717 S. Ervey, in the years 1948 and 1949 as a dance hall officer and their friendship has continued since that time.

Turlington was an employee of Western Electric until 1961 and at that time he moved to Wambahechie and went to work for the Wambahechie Police Department. Turlington was employed as a Police Officer for ten years until 1961 and at that time he went into the Grocery Business.

Turlington stated that he had not seen Subject since one or two weeks before President Kennedy was assassinated, and then only for a few minutes. Turlington stated that Subject was a radical, but never about politics. Turlington said he did not think Ruby was crazy but that he knew he was high tempered and liked to fight.

Turlington further stated that Subject was a close friend of GREGG HAMILTON, w-m, who is a union organizer and has an office some where on Oak Lawn Avenue, Dallas. Subject is also a close friend of a Jewish man named HAWTHORN (two) who used to be in the Punch Board Business on South Harvard Street in 1940 and 1951. Hawthorn is reported to be residing in Chicago, Illinois at the present time.
