Turlington stated that he had heard several people may that Subject is a homosexual, but did not know of his own knowledge of any homosexual activities of Ruby.

Turlington size stated that Suby was a good employer and was easy to work for. Turlington stated that Subject's mister Sys had called him after Subject killed Cawald and asked if he would come to Ballas during the trial, that he might be able to help Subject.
