Pursuent to the instructions of Captain W.P. Ganneway an investigation was conducted regarding SUNJECT and the following report is submitted. This investigation is revelant to the Jack Ruby trial.

Confidential informant T-1 reports that SUBJECT was born July 25, 1923. Place of birth is not known. SUBJECT has maintained residence at 1637 San Jacinto for the past fourteen (1h) years. The telephone number at this location is TA-h-0202. T-1 states that SUBJECT served in the United States Army from February 16, 1943 to November 7, 1945, and was discharged as a Sergeant. T-1 reports that SUBJECT is employed as a musician at the Cattleman's Steak House, 2007 Live Oak, six (6) nights each week, with the G.R. Novatny Orchestra. This orchestra lists the business address of 711 North Oak Cliff Blyd. Prior to joining the Novatny group, SUBJECT played with the Roland Drayer Orchestra. T-1 states that in addition to playing with the aforementioned orchestra SUBJECT maintaines Karl's Piano Service, 1637 San Jacinto. T-1 states that according to their records SUBJECT's father E.C. Wahrmund also lives at 1637 San Jacinto along with SUBJECT.

The indices of the Dallas Police Department Special Service Rureau were searched regarding SUBJECT with negative results.

The indices of the Wallas Police Department Records Bureau were searched regarding SUPJECT with negative results.

The indices of the Dellas Police Department Identification Eureau were searched regarding SIRJECT with the following results. Records of the Identification Eureau reveal that on April 30, 1951 a Mrs. Kurt A. Wahrmund, W/F was sentenced to the Texas Department of Corrections for a period of two (2) years for the offense of Forgery under the number of 125805. At this time Mrs. Wahrmund was fifty-two (52) years of age. Her date of birth being April 15, 1901, at Fredericksburg, Texas. Records reveal that Mrs. Kurt A. Wahrmund was married to one Kurt A. Wahrmund whose address is listed as 1637 San Jacinto, the same as SIMJECT.
