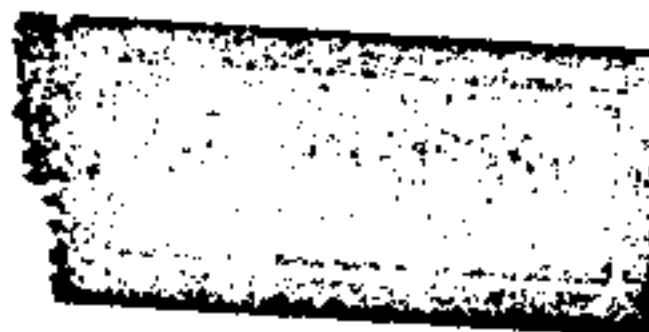
### Faith Regained
