Summary of Case Deceased was riding in motorcade with his wife and Governor Connally and his wife. Witnesses heard gun shot and saw deceased slump forward. More shots were fired and deceased fell forward. Governor Connally was also shot. Officers determined where shots came from and covered the building and went into the building. Capt. Frits had name of Defendant, but Defendant was not in the building. Capt. Frits received information that Defendant had killed Officer Tippit in Oak Cliff. Arresting officers brought Defendant to City Hall.
