Detective J. R. Leavelle, received information concerning the shooting of J. D. Tippit. Received information from Lee Farmer, a witness to the shooting of the officer, who stated he was at the scene where. I also talked with a Mrs. Callaway, c/w, who worked at the Oak Garage, 509 East Jefferson Street, Dallas, Texas. Mrs. Callaway stated that she saw the officer lying in the street at approximately 1:30 PM this date November 22, 1963. She stated she saw the officer lying in the street at approximately 1:30 PM where she identified him as Officer J. D. Tippit. She turned over the officer to Pete Barnes, who was standing

There is another witness, Mrs. Callaway, who stated that she saw the officer lying in the street about 100 feet away at the time he was shot. She stated he was about 100 feet away, when she last saw him. She did not identify the officer as Officer J. D. Tippit, but she did identify him as the officer shot at the Oak Garage.

All of the above officers, Detective J. R. Leavelle, Detective Callaway took the officer to the hospital, but will not be able to say if he died or if he survived the offense.
