ADDITIONAL DETAILS, PROGRESS OF INVESTIGATION, ETC.				

On Nov 22, 1963 approximately 1:18 pm Officer J. M. Poe ¹¹⁷⁵ and I E Jez 1479 working squad 105 heard Police Officer involved in a shooting at 400 blk. of E. Tenth Street. Upon arrival of the scene Officers found abandoned ^{Squad car no 10} with a pool of blood at the left front fender. We were met by a white woman who identified herself as being Helen ~~Marsille~~ Marsille of 329 E. Ninth Street who stated that she witnessed the shooting of the Officer by an unknown white male of about 25 years of age about 5 ft 10 inches, wearing a brown jacket and dark pants. When she went to the aid of the Officer, the suspect threatened to kill her. Unidentified witness handed Officer Poe two empty hulls in an empty cigarette package and stated "these were the bullets that killed the officer." These hulls were released to Sgt. Pete Barnes of the Crimes and Search Section. Officer Tippit had already left the scene when Officers arrived. 6 or 7 witnesses said that the suspect was running east in the alley that was between Tenth and Jefferson.
