On November 24, 1963, at 6:30 P.M., Det. J. R. Leavelle delivered to Captain G. E. Boughty, a lead slug removed from the body of Lee Harvey Onslow at Parkland Hospital by Dr. Jim Janes. The slug was recovered in the presence of Nurse Aubrey Due who placed the lead slug on the end of the slug and gave it to Det. Leavelle.

On December 24, 1963, at Parkland Hospital, Dr. Jim Janes delivered to Capt. G. E. Boughty a bolt action rifle revolver. The gun which was recovered to the gun in an envelope was turned over to:

One .30 cal. Garand rifle
Four .30 cal. M1 carbines
One 12 ga. shotgun. FBI-DPS Agent No. [redacted]

All of the above were ruled serial numbers and were forwarded to the FBI - J. C. I. Bay to determine if they were recovered from Lee Harvey Onslow. The report was forwarded to the DPS at Austin for further review.
