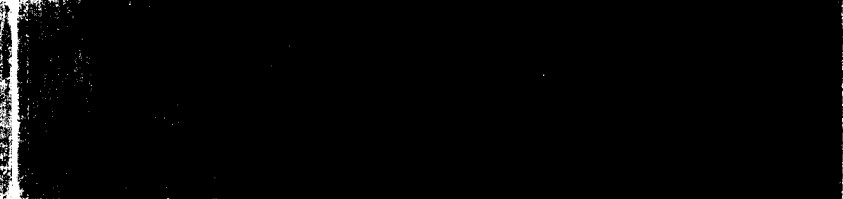

On November 22, 1957, I received a call from Lt. Walls to proceed to Oak Cliff to the scene of a shooting. I arrived at approximately 1:30 PM this date, November 22, 1957. I was met by Sgt. Bud Quins and was told that there was a witness, an ex-officer, that she was with the squad, but did not know the and was with a Red Hallway, manager of a used car lot at 201 East Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois. I was shown the scene and saw subject run from the scene. There was also a witness on this lot as a porter. We also saw the suspect running away from the scene. The witness was brought to City Hall where they identified this suspect, in a line up as the #2 man in a 4 man lineup. This was done at City Hall, November 22, 1957. The first witness, Helen Warburton, was found in the basement room at City Hall. She was shown this same suspect in a line up early in the morning. She identified him as the #2 man in a 4 man lineup. Another witness who was on the street, but did not see suspect, was a Dominic Bonavides, Chicago, Illinois. He was at the scene and picked up 2 spent #9 balls and a shell casing. He in turn gave them to Crime Lab Investigator, J. M. Fox, 1175, who in turn gave them to Crime Lab Investigator, J. M. Fox, who was present and dusted the police car for prints.

The witness has not viewed this suspect, who I have talked to on the phone. He was at Oak Cliff, Number 213, and that he was parked about 20 feet from the shooting take place, that the suspect ran past him in a matter of a few seconds. The year don't recall about talking. He will be able to identify the suspect. The witness's name is M. J. Scovino, 1175, Chicago, Illinois. He works at the office, 930 West Davis, WF 7-6203.

The witness, with the exception of Scovino, made affidavits. I took the officer's signal and got in the cab with hoodlums and returned suspect to the station.
