He states that on the night of 12-3-63 between 8:30 and 9:00 PM that an unknown man (sounded like a young man's voice) called him at home, and started off by asking, "What's the name of the Chimaman that strong armed the Actor's Guild?" Ar. Clark asked who it was calling, and the man refused to give his name.
