On invoice sheet # 11132-G it showed they had picked up from the Dallas Police Dept: 1-Manox Camera- One Padometer, One Compass. One Hansa self timer, One lons in hood, One Fifteentx power telescope, wallensak, One Sterio Viever, One pocket knife in leather container, A photograph, No. 375 was taken of the above articles.

came to the property room and referred to our invoice #1136-G and stated they did not get the camera as shown above, that they got only the Ninox Light meter. He requested that I note on invoice #11138\*6 his statement regarding the Minox Camera. I did so note. I do not remember the name of the agent who came to the property room and made this request; I did not write his ware down.
