Nov. 26, 1963, The F. B. I. took property and evidence which had been seized in connection with arrest of Lee Harvey Oswald, for assassination of President Kennedy, to their office in the Santa Fe Building. I accompanied the agents and property to the F B I Office, and I was present when Agent Warren C. De-Brueys checked each item, called the name of item and description off to their Stenographer, who typed the descriptions on Police Property room official invoice or receipt sheets. On invoice sheet # 11132-G it showed they had picked up from the Dallas Police Dept: 1-Minox Camera- One Pedometer, -One Compass. One Hansa self timer, One lens in hood, One FifteenXX power telescope, Wallensak, One Stereo Viewer, One pocket knife in leather container, A photograph, No. 375 was taken of the above articles.

Quite some time later, several weeks, an agent of the F B I came to the property room and referred to our invoice #11132-G and stated they did not get the camera as shown above, that they got only the Minox Light meter. He requested that I note on invoice #11132-G his statement regarding the Minox Camera. I did so note. I do not remember the name of the agent who came to the property room and made this request, I did not write his name down.
