At 1:38 P.M., August 1, 1961, while working squad # 83, I received a signal 18 call to 6th and Woodlawn. I heard the call dispatched and attempted to acknowledge. I tried to acknowledge the call two or three more times while proceeding to the location of the call.

At 1:41 P.M., squad # 91, the district squad of the location of my call, cleared. Squad # 91 was given the signal 18 at 6th and Woodlawn at 1:42 P.M. At this time I was able to contact the Dispatcher thinking he was transferring the call to the district squad. I did not realize I was being given a missed call sheet.
