As you know, November 22nd
marked the 2nd sad anniversary
of the assassination of the
late President John F. Kennedy
by Lee Harvey Oswald.
As you recall, LEE HARVEY OSWALD,
who also shot and killed DALLAS
Policeman J. D. TIPPIT, who
attempted to question OSWALD,
was captured in a Dallas
movie theater by six Dallas
Policemen at the extreme
risk of their lives.
Please advise if you would
be in favor of the introduction
of Resolutions in the U.S. SENATE
and U.S. House of REPRESENTATIVES
to award special Congressional
medals for bravery with
appropriate honors and
ceremonies to the late Dallas
Policeman J. D. TIPPIT and the
other six courageous DALLAS
Policemen who apprehended
Lee Harvey OSWALD.
