There is in my heart a feeling of deep sympathy for young Mrs. Oswald and a great joy in the generous response of these youngsters. I feel no censure of anyone for the events of late November, only a deep sadness and a determination to do whatever small things I can to help replace hate with love.

The children who send these gifts have great faith that their gifts will be delivered in time for Christmas. I share that faith, and I earnestly hope that you will be able to do whatever is possible for you to do, in order not to discourage their desire to share wherever there is need. This, of course, is what is important about this box; its contents are of no real value in themselves but are gifts of love.
