On developing the migrofilm it has been found that items #164 through 360 inclusive did not record. It is requested that the Federal Bureau of Investigation Laboratory in Washington be requested to photograph these items and forward them to the Dallas Police Department as part of our evidence in the Lee Harvey Oswald case.
