Sir:

A point I am not sure of is:

Was the bullet (or bullets) fired at retired
Gen. U.S.A. Walker in his Highland Park
home in Dallas tested ballistically to
prove that the gun found in the
Texas Book Depository fired this
same bullet (or bullets)?

So much - years of books & testimony
has obliterated the fact that Gen. Walker
was shot at in his home in April 1968
and that the assassin-attempting was
not discovered at the time. And recall
he shot thru a window (open or broken
glass was not mentioned in Wall Street Journal
article) and possibly ~~left~~ left the expended
spent shell (or shells) outside the window.
Tho a car must have been employed for
a quick get-away if alert Police Patrol
followed by a radio call, witnesses, etc.

Gen. Walker is a staunch anti-Communist
& believe. Tho this assassination attempt was
not front page headline in Pittsburgh where I
was, it seemed well on with American
sneaking way of operating ~~and~~ separate hat

Tho how a guy could miss a short
range shot at such close quarters and then
make a long shot at moving & obscured
