Chief Batchelor:

Re your letter 14 May.

My inquiry had to do solely with the General Walker incident of April 1963. Since this took place in a Dallas suburb - Highland Park - I suppose your police file records would show that the case investigation was completed. In turn, this would close the case file.

As it is, from my security news sources of the papers, this American citizen was prompted to make sure the General Walker <sup>incident</sup> was closed; as it may be that the subversive persons (or person) who took a pot-shot at the General were still at large.

Not to be alarmist and strictly to utilize due process of law, it can only be noted that the Communist menace so deplored by J. Edgar Hoover and the F.B.I. since 1947 (see Don Whitehead "The FBI Story") has been greatly aided by Chief Justice Warren & the Supreme Court in not recognizing the menace to our sovereign United States of America; by registering these persons and/or deporting them as un-American aliens.
