The positive angle of ballistics tests to prove the gunshot and gun ownership were available to your Police Dept; and I supposed Police Records would show the results. Also, it could have provided, at the time, a scrutinizable attempt at relation of the incident as to means employed and person (or persons) in the Oak Cliff, or other suburb, who could have entered Highland Park and 'attempted' the General, so unsuccessfully, at night; and, especially, to bridge the coincidence of finding a really 'perfect' shot on a one-time visit and 'missing' it. It is alarming indeed. Who did it and why.
