Subject: Items of Clothing of Lee Harvey Oswald
in Possession of Dallas Police Department

On the instructions of Mr. Tim Timmins, Assistant United States Attorney, Northern District of Texas, you will ship by sealed express, return receipt requested, to the National Archives, 8th Street & Pennsylvania, Northwest, Washington, D. C., ATTENTION: Mr. Marion Johnson, the following items which were removed from the body of Lee Harvey Oswald at Parkland Hospital at the time of his death:

- One black slip-on sweater.
- One under shirt.
- One shirt.
- One pair of dark colored trousers.
- One pair of dark colored socks.
- One pair of black slip-on shoes.
- One torn piece of white paper found in right front pocket of Oswald's trousers.

This you will do in compliance with Public Law 89-318 (79 Stat. 1185) enacted by the Congress of the United States becoming a public law November 2, 1965.
