Nov. 26, 1963, The F. B. I. took property and evidence which had been seized in connection with arrest of Lee Harvey Oswald, for assination of President Kennedy, to their office in the Santa Fe building. I accompained the agents and property to the F B I Office, and I was present when Agent Warren C. Ac-Brueys checked each item, called the name of item and description off. to their Stenographer, who typed the descriptions on Police Property room official invoice or recient sheets. 2 On invoice sheet # 11132-G it showed they had picked up from the Dallas Police Dept; 1-Minox Camera- One Pedometer, One Compass. One Hansa self timer, One lons in hood, One Fifteen XX power telescope, wallensak, One Sterio Viewer, One pocket knife in leather container, A photograph, No. 375 was taken of the above articles.

Quite some time later, Reveral weeks, an agent of the F B I came to the property room and referred to our invoice #11190-G and stated they did not get the camera as shown above, that they got only the Ninox Light meter. He requested that I note on invoice #11192\*6 his statement regarding the Minox Camera. I did so note. I do not remember the name of the agent who came to the property room and made this request, I did not write his wame down.
