

Page 2, PREPARATION FOR JOHN F. KENNEDY VISIT, February 5, 1964

After a diligent investigation it was determined that only two of those organizations were planning demonstrations during the KENNEDY'S visit to DALLAS.

The INDIGNANT WHITE CITIZEN'S COUNCIL had prepared some signs and placards which were to embarrass Mr. KENNEDY. Their plans were to picket the DALLAS TRADE MART during his speaking engagement there.

The GENERAL MARTIN A. WALKER GROUP intended to embarrass Mr. KENNEDY by picketing the parade route and also the DALLAS TRADE MART.

Prior to the President's visit, information was received that members of the YOUNG PROGRESSIVE REPUBLICAN CLUB from NORTH TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY at DENTON, TEXAS, were meeting with GENERAL WALKER and making plans. According to a reliable source, this group stated they intended to "rub the President's dick in the dirt." These individuals were identified and photographs of them were obtained.

The only demonstrators observed at the DALLAS TRADE MART were members of the INDIGNANT WHITE CITIZEN'S COUNCIL. Six of these individuals were taken into custody shortly after knowledge of the assassination became known. This step was taken to prevent these persons from being assaulted by spectators at the scene. The arrested persons of this group are as follows:



The GENERAL WALKER GROUP did not make an appearance. A reliable source stated that GENERAL WALKER had departed from DALLAS on November 21, 1963, enroute to another state for a speaking engagement.
