The indices of the REPUBLIC NATIONAL BANK failed to reveal any information regarding SUBJECT being the co-maker of any loans for any Police Officers of this Department. This search of indices was made through MR. LEO BROWN, Vice-President of REPUBLIC NATIONAL BANK.

The indices of the FIRST NATIONAL BANK failed to reveal SUBJECT as being the co-maker for any loans to Police Officers of this Department. It was further determined that SUBJECT has never been involved in any business transactions at this bank. The search of indices was made through MR. DONALD WALKER, Chairman of the Executive Committee of the FIRST NATIONAL BANK.

The indices of the ONE CLIFF BANK & TRUST COMPANY failed to reveal any information regarding SUBJECT. It has also been determined that SUBJECT has not been the co-maker on any notes or loans to any Police Officers of this Department. SUBJECT has never conducted any business transactions at this bank. The search of indices was made through MR. J.C. BROWN, President, and MR. THOMPSON, bank auditor.
