Sir:

I should like to submit the fellowing report of the events occurring in the basement on Hovember 24, 1963.

I was in a group of detectives under Captain Jones and-Lieutenant Smart on Hovember 24, 1963, at about 11:30 a.m. or a little later. The group was to assist in keeping press sen and photographers back while Captain fritz and his men brought bee Harvey Oswald down from the City Jail to an armored truck waiting at the top of the basement ramp. The Ballus Sheriff's Office was waiting with the armored truck to transfer Oswald to the County Dheriff's office for confinement.

I was standing at the northwest corner of the driveway opening in the basement approximately 26 feet east of the jail office door.

As Captain Fritz came out of the jail door and came east toward the parking area in the besencest, he was followed closely by Lee Harvey Usuald with detectives holding both arms and other detectives in edictely behind Cawald. As I saw Captain Fritz and then looked at Cavald and the detectives holding and following him, they reached a point dust past the corner where they would turn right to go up the remp approximately 75 feet to the waiting armored car.

I was looking to the right book toward the jail office and hall in front of the jail office. At this time I heard a loud noise like a gun firing or a firecracker. I never saw anyone at I was looking right and the sound was muffled as if it were a gun jammed close to someone and fired. As I looked back left, six or eight detectives or more grabbed a man and wrattled him to the floor. I did not touch him as there were too many officers on him already.

The officers carried the suspect back to the jail office. During this time I was watching press men and photographers to keep down any interference. I just stayed in the interdiste area and tried to keep anyone from leaving. I then went to the jail office door and kept unauthorized persons out and, as I looked in, I saw the suspect clearly lying on the floor, being held by Police.

I guarded the jail door until they took Oswald out to a waiting ambulance in this same basement driveway. I haw
