I arrived flunday morning, invender 2h, 1963 about 8:00 am. We word from Fir. Ferry, recurity Officer of the Statler-Hilton that they check in who said he represented a munition company out of California. the hotel in company with Pet. C. W. Thority and Mr. C. W. Brown. We with Robert W. Parker, 5hh Worth Cyroso, Trange, California. We satisfully declared to the office.

At 9:30 am I was instructed, along with let. L. C. Graves and Dot Dhority to go up in the jail one get too Oswald. I went to his cell as handouff on him with his hands in front of him.

We returned to Captain critz's office whore Captain Fritz, Mr. Sci and Mr. Thomas Kelly of the Secret Service questioned Oswald. Also in were Detectives L. D. Montgomery, L. C. Graves, C. N. Dhority and Inspec Holmes of the rest Office Department and myself.

Captain Fritz's office. - had made a suggestion earlier to double cross press and take Oswald out on the first floor via the -ain ftreet door, le the press waiting in the basement and on Commune Street.

Also it was suggested to go out the Main Otreet ramp and west on Ma These suggestions were turned down by Chief Curry who stated that we had go ahead with the transfer as planned, wince he had given his word on it.

pproximately 11:15 am we left the third floor office with Uswald h. to my left arm with Dot. L. C. Graves holding to Oswald's left arm, precede the jail elevator by Captain Fritz, Lt. Swain, Detective L. D. Montgomery. reached the basement jail office with officers in front we headed to the a gramp just outside the jail office door. We hesitated just inside the jail
