
H. B. Reynolds was interviewed by Lieutenants C. C. Wallace and P. G. McCaghren at 2:30 pm on November 29, 1963. The interview was essentially the same as his original report dated November 27, 1963. The following was added by H. B. Reynolds:


I have been asked if I know Jack Ruby, and I do not. I did not see him prior to the shooting and was unable to see him after the shooting.

On the morning of November 29, 1963, in the sub basement of the City Hall, I over heard a conversation between Officer Vaughn and an officer unknown to me regarding Jack Ruby. The officer not known to me stated to Vaughn that he had seen a picture of Jack Ruby where there was a press card stuck in his hat.

I have not been interviewed by anyone regarding this incident prior to this date.
