Sir:

I should like to submit the following report of the events occurring in the basement on Hovember 24, 1963.

I was in a group of detectives under Captain Jones and Lieutenant Smart on Hovember 24, 1963, at about 11:30 a.m. or a little later. The group was to assist in keeping press men and photographers back while Captain Tritz and his men brought bee Marvey Cowald down from the City Jail to an armored truck waiting at the top of the basement ramp. The Calles Sheriff's Office was waiting with the armored truck to transfer Oswald to the County Cheriff's office for confinement.

I was standing at the northwest corner of the driveway opening in the basement approximately 26 feet east of the jail office door.

As Captain Fritz case out of the joil door and case east toward the parking area in the besement, he was followed closely by Lee Harvey Oswald with detectives holding both arms and other detectives in sodictely behind Gowald. As I saw Captain Fritz and then looked at Cowald and the detectives holding and following him, they reached a point just past the corner where they would turn right to go up the rump approximately 75 feet to the waiting armored car.

I was looking to the right took toward the jail office and hall in front of the jail office. At this time I heard a loud noise like a gen firing or a firecracker. I never saw anyone at I was looking right and the sound was muffled as if it were a gun jammed close to someone and fired. As I looked back loft, six or eight detectives or more grabbed a man and wroatled him to the floor. I did not touch him as there were too many officers on him already.

The officers carried the suspect back to the jail office. During this time I was watching press men and photographers to keep down any interference. I just stayed in the in-mediate area and tried to keep anyone from leaving. I then went to the jail office door and kept unauthorized persons out and, as I looked in, I saw the suspect clerrly lying on the floor, being held by Police.

I guarded the jail door until they took Cawald out to a waiting ambulance in this same basement driveway. I haw
