Who, after being by me duly sworn, an oath deposes and says: I work for the Texns School Book Depository, all Elm Strest, as a Checker on the first floor for Mr. Roy S. Truly. On Friday, November 22, 1963, I got to work at 8:05 a.m. The first time I saw Lee Oswald on Friday, November 22, 1963 was about 8:15 a.m. He was filling orders on the first floor. A little after 9:00 a.m. Les Oswald asked me wint all the people were doing standing on the street. I told him that the President was supposed to come this way sometime this morning. He asked may, "Thich may do you think he is coming?". I told him that the President would probably come down Main Street and turn on Houston and then go down Eln Street. He said, "Yes, I see". I only talked with him for about three or four minutes. The last time I saw Lee Oswald on Friday, November 22, 1963 was between 11:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon when he was taking the elevator upstairs to go get some boxes. At about 11:45 a.m. all of the exployees who were working on the 6th floor came downstairs and we were all out on the street at about 12:00 o'clock noon. These employees were: Bill Shelley, Charles Givens, Billy Lovelady, Bonnie Ray (last name not known) and a Spanish boy (his name I cannot remember).
