Pursuant to the instructions of Captain W.L. Gannaway, a background investigation was conducted on Subj C. and the following is submitted.

The indices of the Identification Bureau of the Dallas County Sheriff's Office revealed that Subj C. was born 20 July 1944 in CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, the daughter of LILLIAN and RALPH ERICKSON. These indices revealed that Subj C. does not know the whereabouts of either of her parents. The only arrest record on Subj C. was in JAIL # 10001 court for ----. The F.B.I. return sheet indicated no previous arrests.

Confidential informant T-1 stated that Subj C. formerly resided at 2005 PARK AVENUE and 1305 PARK ST. in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. Subj C.'s last known address was 3807 LINDENWOOD, JACKSONVILLE, FLA. Subj C. was living at that address with BILLY COLEMAN w-m, common law husband. T-1 was unable to give any address for Subj C. in Dallas even though Subj C. has been employed in Dallas at the COLONIAL MOTEL. T-1 has had no inquiries on Subj C. T-1 further stated that Subj C. has several charge accounts in JACKSONVILLE that are past due and considered uncollectable. T-1 also stated that Subj C. has been employed at the HYATT HOTEL and the 500 CLUB and the COLONIAL MOTEL in JACKSONVILLE, FLA. .

The indices of the records Bureau of the F.B.I. and FBIIC, Dallas office revealed that Subj C. was reported missing by her grandmother, Mrs. EDITH WILCOX, of 4228 N. VICTORIA. This offense was later unfounded. A copy of this report is included as enclosure # 1. A copy of F.B.I. MEMORANDUM, INTER-OFFICE COMMUNICATION is included as enclosure # 2.
