

Q. Can you think of anything else that he said to you after 4:00 PM?

A. He stated "do you really believe that they used a Jewish name to cover up for a Gentile?" and also about the black border, because in the Jewish faith it stands for death.

Q. Alright, now how long did he stay?

A. I would say until 7:15 PM.

Q. Did he eat?

A. I asked him what he wanted to eat and he said scrambled eggs and lex, which I prepared for him and which he ate in spurts, because he was on the phone most of the time.

Q. How many calls did he make?

A. He made four phone calls. I believe to the Carousel and to a fellow by the name of Don Safrino (two calls to him). He called the newspaper. I don't know which one or both of them. He made the calls to tell them that the club was going to be closed. He told Don Safrino he would not be open that night, or on Saturday. I do not recall whether or not he said he would be open on Sunday. He ate a bite. He then placed another call I believe to Alice.

Q. How long did he stay at your place?

A. I believe until about 7:15.

Q. Did he say where he was going?

A. He said he was going home to change because he was going to pray at the synagogue. (He got talking about his father who is deceased.) "I never had such a feeling in my life, even when Pa died."

Q. He said he was going to the Synagogue to pray for the President?

A. Yes.

Q. Did you hear from him anymore that night?

A. He called about 10:30 or 11:00.

Q. What was the content of his conversation?

He said he was going to the police station and he asked how I felt.
