SUBJECT stated that this man was positively Lab Habby OFFALD. SUBJECT said this man stated that he was waiting for JACK RUBY. SUBJECT stated that JACK RUBY entered the CAFE a short time later but did not sit in the booth with this man. The man helieved to be OSCALD went over and set with JACK RUBY. SUBJECT stated that RUBY and the man believed to be OSCALD left at approximately 2:45 A, II. At this point in the interview the SUBJECT stated that she could not be sure that this man was OSCALD but if he had a small deep scar on his left check, it was him.

SUBJECT stated that a few days after the assassination she received an amonymous telephone call telling her to ret out of town or she would die.

Pefore the interview ended the STAJACT stated that she could not be positive but she thought the man with Rivey was OSMAIO.
